ANAK NG PASIG

PASIG RIVER



Pasig River is a historical and ecological landmark of great significance in the Philippines. It has sadly earned the nickname of "Metro Manila's sewage system" due to the substantial volume of waste discharged into its waters. Despite the government's initiatives to enhance the condition of the Pasig River, the situation persists in deteriorating over time.

GOAL OF THIS LESSON PLAN

To understand the history

conversation on the

7th, 8th, 9th, 10th,
11th, 12th

Duration:
50 MINUTES

OBJECTIVES

- To understand the history of the Pasig River revitalization and its importance
- To connect with the environment through the song "Anak ng Pasig"
- To initiate a conversation on the importance of maintaining river systems in the Philippines

RESOURCES

- “Anak ng Pasig” song lyrics
- “The Pasig River Today” video
- For 11th and 12th grade: additional resource (research paper)





QUESTIONS FOR REFLECTION

- What is the moral of the song?
- What did you feel after listening to the song? How about after watching the video of rehabilitation?

INTRODUCTION

- Play the “Anak ng Pasig” song twice
- Discuss initial ideas from the song
- Play the video (rehabilitation)

Duration:
15 MINUTES

ANALYZE

- Group the students into 3-4 groups (depending on class size)
- Each group must discuss on what they have listened to and the video they watched.
- They must come up with a 3-minute role play showcasing what was the problem (based on the song) and what was the solution (based on the video).

Duration:
15 MINUTES

DISCUSSION / COLLABORATION

- Group Presentation
- After all the groups have presented, discuss the scenarios that they came up with and allow conversations around the classroom.
- Use the remaining time to talk about their performances.

Duration:
15 MINUTES

ASSESSMENT / REFLECTION

Call 2-3 students to **answer the Questions for Reflection**

** Follow up as an assignment if possible.
